







STREAM in Tajikistan



Acted is an international NGO providing help in 43 countries since 1993 through humanitarian, development and environmental projects. Acted has been in Tajikistan since 1996 and carries out projects across different sectors, making a significant impact on disaster risk reduction, water and sanitation, agriculture and rural development, education and skills development, social cohesion and peacebuilding, humanitarian assistance, and capacity building.

STREAM in Tajikistan aims to improve **regional water resources management** in the vulnerable regions of the **Ferghana Valley** by supporting the development of **water accounting systems**, building **capacities** of local actors, and **facilitating meetings** for integrated water resources management.

Initial watersheds / target areas:

Khojabakirgan, Sughd region

National Partners: Ministry of Energy and Water Resources, Community-based organizations, Water User Associations and Pasture User Associations

Key stakeholders: Local government and water authorities (village to national level), River Basin Organizations, Water User Associations, Pasture Committees, CSOs working on NRM, and end users

Timeframe: August 2022 – May 2026

Pillar I: Evidence-based planning

Targeted watershed level context, NRM and climate change analysis, stakeholder mobilization and road map development with local actors and national governments.

Pillar II: Climate smart NRM practices

Provision of capacity building training, technical expertise and supports (secondment, equipment, etc.) and small grant schemes for stakeholders.

Pillar III: Infrastructure and dialogue

Focused investment in infrastructure rehabilitation and accompanying water accounting systems and information management approaches to facilitate regional dialogue.
