





STREAM in Uzbekistan



Acted is an INGO working across 43 countries globally in pursuit of its triple mandate as a humanitarian, development, and environmental actor in response to the triple planetary crisis. Since 1999, Acted Uzbekistan works on strengthening civil society and good governance, gender equality, green economy, natural resource management and climate change adaptation, disaster risk management and emergency response.

STREAM in Uzbekistan aims to empower rural women and local authorities in selected districts of the Ferghana region through capacity-building on integrated water resources management (IWRM). The objective is to enhance IWRM efficiency in vulnerable target areas of the Fergana region by introducing a reliable water monitoring system, improving data sharing, establishing demonstration sites, and rehabilitating water infrastructure.

Target areas:

Toshloq, Quva, Chimyon and Vodil areas in Fergana region (7500 programme participants).

Main National Partner: Informational-Analytical Resource Center, under the Ministry of Water Resources of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Key stakeholders: Uzhydromet, State Committee for Family and Women, Basin Departments of Irrigation Systems, SIC ICWC, Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change, State Committee for Ecology.

Timeframe: August 2023 – May 2026.

Pillar I: Evidence-based planning

Targeted watershed level context, NRM and climate change analysis, stakeholder mobilisation and road map development with local and national actors governments.

Pillar II: Climate smart NRM practices

Provision of capacity building training, technical expertise and supports (secondment, equipment, etc.) and small grant schemes for stakeholders.

Pillar III: Infrastructure and dialogue

Focused investment infrastructure rehabilitation accompanying accounting systems and information management approaches facilitate to regional dialogue.
