2. Tenderers will fill, sign, stamp and return the Offer form according to ACTED's format.
3. Tenderers will sign and return all pages of the Product Specifications for which they apply.
4. The offer to the call for tender will not result in the award of a contract.

6. Unsealed envelope and late offers will not be considered.
7. Information session & Site visit for the interested bidders will be conducted in Mafraq governorate (N32.3311773, E36.2213971) on the **28/08/2018** at **11:00 AM**. Participation of interested bidders to the information session is compulsory.
8. A tender opening session will take place on **16/09/2018** at **2:00 PM** in the ACTED representative office in Amman. The presence of bidders' representative is allowed. 9. To ensure that funds are used exclusively for humanitarian purposes and in accordance with donors' compliance requirements, all contract offers are subject to the condition that contractors do not appear on anti-terrorism lists, in line with ACTED's anti-terrorism policy. To this end, ACTED reserves the right to carry out anti-terrorism checks on contractor, its board members, staff, volunteers, consultants, financial service providers and sub-contractor."

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS :

The Bills of quantities and its introduction constitute a fundamental part of the tender document.

- 1) Bids prices are to be submitted in Jordanian Dinars.
- 2) If Items Specification in the description in the B.O.Q are not detailed, Bidders should refer to the other tender documents to assess the requirements prior to pricing the items.
- 3) Bidders should price all B.O.Q items, the prices submitted by the Contractor will have to be valid for entire project area, at no extra cost except for the case allowed by the contract conditions.
- 4) Cost of dewatering of sites, where needed, will not be reimbursed, and it is considered imbedded in the total cost of the priced items. The necessary works needed at water & waste water lines intersection as well as supply of water for executing the works are also considered imbedded in the other priced items cost.
- 5) The unit price includes, but necessary limited to the temporary & preparatory works, site guarding, lighting, safe paths for people, profit and all other expenses and risk alleviation measures as well as the project sign board and supervision site offices, required in the special specification's & conditions.
Moreover, the unit prices are considered comprehensive, and covering the protection off all work, and services, shown or not shown on drawings, that might be subject to danger, during the construction. It also includes the cost of preparing shop drawing and the required testing.
- 6) The quoted prices in the BOQ are considered as the real value of items including all required works as per the specifications, Drawings and engineer's directions. The prices also include the contractor's profit and other obligations that he will bear, according to the contract specifications and terms.
- 7) Unit prices include protection of all existing structures and Services as well as reinstatement of them all to the original condition, comprising underground pipes and trees and agricultural soil as per the Engineer's directions.
- 8) Unit prices are to be filled in writing and in numbers.
- 9) Any additional item that entails additional cost, supplied and/or installed by the Contractor without the prior approval of the Engineer will not be measured and reimbursed.
- 10) Contractor should use salt resistant cement, in concrete works, at no extra cost to the client.
- 11) The contractor should submit cost analyses for all project B.O.Q items.
- 12) Unit prices are fixed, and No Consideration for extra allowance will be given to compensate for increase or decreases of quantities, whether small or substantial.

Measurements and Payments

- 1) The B.O.Q item quantities are estimated, and listed for fixing the unit prices taking in account type and diameters of pipes as well as ground surface conditions that is expected during the contract. The quantities are subject to decrease and increase in undefined percentage. The contractors will be paid for the actual measured quantities (considering the roads surfaces type).
 - a) Ductile Iron Pipes: the price includes pipe lying and accessories of different types and diameters such as elbows, tees, reducers, plugs, clamps, flanges and special pieces...etc. as well as excavation, backfilling, pipe lying, necessary connections and supply of pastes and material needed for pipe connections, thrust blocks, rubber gaskets, plastic or metal warning tapes, electronic identifiers, washing and sterilization, cutting trenches and filling with approved materials all needed accessories, and supply of pastes, as well as concrete encasement for pipes of 2" diameter or more crossing the roads and all contractors obligations as per specification, Drawings and engineer's directions.
The price also includes field hydraulic pressure test, and reinstatement of surfaces to the original conditions.
 - b) Polyethylene pipe. The price includes all items mentioned in "1.a" above.
- 2) The water and wastewater lines will be measured in meter runs for the constructed pipes taking in account the ground surface type as well as the type and diameter of pipes, identifying the existing surface type. Measurement will be performed on the center lines of pipes for the length indicated in the drawings from beginning to the end of the line. Accessories will not be deducted from measurement neither will be the pipe inside the manholes.
- 3) Valves and vents will be measured in numbers. The unit price includes the necessary and needed works in conformity with detailed drawings and BOQ.
- 4) The supervising Engineer will be working and available 5 days a week. Works on holidays or Saturdays will not be allowed without the approval of ACTED's Engineering team.
Will it be necessary to work on holidays and/ outside working hours, the Contractor will pay the cost of over time supervision including the transportation.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Labour Standards

The labour standards in this code are based on the conventions of the International Labour Organisation (ILO).

- *Employment is freely chosen*

There is no forced, bonded or involuntary prison labour. Workers are not required to lodge 'deposits' or their identity papers with the employer and are free to leave their employer after reasonable notice.

- *Freedom of association and the right to collective bargaining are respected*

Workers, without distinction, have the right to join or form trade unions of their own choosing and to bargain collectively. The employer adopts an open attitude towards the legitimate activities of trade unions. Workers representatives are not discriminated against and have access to carry out their representative functions in the workplace. Where the right to freedom of association and collective bargaining is restricted under law, the employer facilitates, and does not hinder, the development of parallel means for independent and free association and bargaining.

- *Working conditions are safe and hygienic*

A safe and hygienic working environment shall be provided, bearing in mind the prevailing knowledge of the industry and of any specific hazards. Adequate steps shall be taken to prevent accidents and injury to health arising out of, associated with, or occurring in the course of work, by minimising, so far as is reasonably practicable, the causes of hazards inherent in the working environment. Workers shall receive regular and recorded health and safety training, and such training shall be repeated for new or reassigned workers. Access to clean toilet facilities and potable water and, if appropriate, sanitary facilities for food storage shall be provided. Accommodation, where provided, shall be clean, safe, and meet the basic needs of the workers. The company observing the standards shall assign responsibility for health and safety to a senior management representative.

- *Child Labour shall not be used*

There shall be no new recruitment of child labour. Companies shall develop or participate in and contribute to policies and programmes, which provide for the transition of any child found to be performing child labour to enable her/him to attend and remain in quality education until no longer a child. Children and young people under 18 years of age shall not be employed at night or in hazardous conditions. These policies and procedures shall conform to the provisions of the relevant International Labour Organisation (ILO) standards.

- *Living wages are paid*

Wages and benefits paid for a standard working week meet, at a minimum, national legal standards or industry benchmarks. In any event wages should always be high enough to meet basic needs and to provide some discretionary income. All workers shall be provided with written and understandable information about their

employment conditions in respect to wages before they enter employment, and about the particulars of their wages for the pay period concerned each time that they are paid. Deductions from wages as a disciplinary measure shall not be permitted nor shall any deductions from wages not provided for by national law be permitted without the express and informed permission of the worker concerned. All disciplinary measures should be recorded.

- *Working hours are not excessive*

Working hours comply with national laws and benchmark industry standards, whichever affords greater protection. In any event, workers shall not on a regular basis be required to work in excess of the local legal working hours. Overtime shall be voluntary, shall not exceed local legal limits, shall not be demanded on a regular basis and shall always be compensated at a premium rate.

- *No discrimination is practised*

There is no discrimination in hiring, compensation, access to training, promotion, termination or retirement based on race, caste, national origin, religion, age, disability, gender, marital status, sexual orientation, union membership or political affiliation.

- *Regular employment is provided*

To every extent possible work performed must be on the basis of a recognised employment relationship established through national law and practice. Obligations to employees under labour or social security laws and regulations arising from the regular employment relationship shall not be avoided through the use of labour-only contracting, sub-contracting or home-working arrangements, or through apprenticeship schemes where there is no real intent to impart skills or provide regular employment, nor shall any such obligations be avoided through the excessive use of fixed-term contracts of employment.

- *No harsh or inhumane treatment is allowed*

Physical abuse or discipline, the threat of physical abuse, sexual or other harassment and verbal abuse or other forms of intimidation shall be prohibited.

B. Environmental Standards

Suppliers should as a minimum comply with all statutory and other legal requirements relating to the environmental impacts of their business. Detailed performance standards are a matter for suppliers, but should address at least the following:

- *Waste Management*

Waste is minimised and items recycled whenever this is practicable. Effective controls of waste in respect of ground, air, and water pollution are adopted. In the case of hazardous materials, emergency response plans are in place.

- *Packaging and Paper*

Undue and unnecessary use of materials is avoided, and recycled materials used whenever appropriate.

- *Conservation*

Processes and activities are monitored and modified as necessary to ensure that conservation of scarce resources, including water, flora and fauna and productive land in certain situations.

- *Energy Use*

All production and delivery processes, including the use of heating, ventilation, lighting, IT systems and transportation, are based on the need to maximise efficient energy use and to minimise harmful emissions.

- **Safety precautions for transport and cargo handling**

All transport and cargo handling processes are based on the need to maximise safety precautions and to minimise potential injuries to ACTED beneficiaries and staff as well as the suppliers' employees or those of its subcontractors.

C. Business Behaviour

The conduct of the supplier should not violate the basic rights of ACTED's beneficiaries.

The supplier should not be engaged

1. in the manufacture of arms
2. in the sale of arms to governments which systematically violate the human rights of their citizens; or where there is internal armed conflict or major tensions; or where the sale of arms may jeopardise regional peace and security.

D. ACTED procurement rules and regulations

Suppliers should comply with ACTED procurement rules and regulations outlines in ACTED Logistics Manual Version 1.2. or above. In particular, ACTED's procurement policy set out in Section 2.1 and 2.4. (contract awarding). By doing so, Suppliers acknowledge that they do not find themselves in any of the situations of exclusion as referred to under section 2.4.2.

Operating Principles

The implementation of the Code of Conduct will be a shared responsibility between ACTED and its suppliers, informed by a number of operating principles, which will be reviewed from time to time.

ACTED will:

1. Assign responsibility for ensuring compliance with the Code of Conduct to a senior manager.
2. Communicate its commitment to the Code of Conduct to employees, supporters and donors, as well as to all suppliers of goods and services.
3. Make appropriate human and financial resources available to meet its stated commitments, including training and guidelines for relevant personnel.
4. Provide guidance and reasonable non-financial support to suppliers who genuinely seek to promote and implement the Code standards in their own business and in the relevant supply chains, within available resources.
5. Adopt appropriate methods and systems for monitoring and verifying the achievement of the standards.
6. Seek to maximise the beneficial effect of the resources available, e.g. by collaborating with other NGOs, and by prioritising the most likely locations of non-compliance.

ACTED expects suppliers to:

1. Accept responsibility for labour and environmental conditions under which products are made and services provided. This includes all work contracted or sub-contracted and that conducted by home or other out-workers.
2. Assign responsibility for implementing the Code of Conduct to a senior manager.
3. Make a written Statement of Intent regarding the company's policy in relation to the Code of Conduct and how it will be implemented, and communicate this to staff and suppliers as well as to ACTED.

Both parties will

1. Require the immediate cessation of serious breaches of the Code and, where these persist, terminate the business relationship.
2. Seek to ensure all employees are aware of their rights and involved in the decisions which affect them.
3. Avoid discriminating against enterprises in developing countries.
4. Recognise official regulation and inspection of workplace standards, and the interests of legitimate trades unions and other representative organisations.

5. Seek arbitration in the case of unresolved disputes.

Qualifications to the Policy Statement

The humanitarian imperative is paramount. Where speed of deployment is essential in saving lives, ACTED will purchase necessary goods and services from the most appropriate available source.

ACTED can accept neither uncontrolled cost increases nor drops in quality. It accepts appropriate internal costs but will work with suppliers to achieve required ethical standards as far as possible at no increase in cost or decrease in quality.
