#### **ACTED's Dedicated Helpline**


In cooperation with LibAid and the Municipality of Benghazi, ACTED established a dedicated helpline. People can call to report their needs and in turn we put them in touch with service providers as part of our referral system.


The helpline receives calls from concerned individuals such as the internally displaced population, returnees and the vulnerable communities in Benghazi. We provide a safe and secure communication channel and our aim is to provide as much assistance as possible.

### **ACTED** in Libya

ACTED has been operating in Libya since 2011, delivering humanitarian assistance and support to civil society, social enterprises and local governance in Misrata, Tripoli, Sabha and Benghazi Districts. The capital office is located in Tunis with permanent field offices in the cities of Benghazi and Tripoli.

Since 2011 ACTED has implemented multiple projects in Benghazi and this project specifically focuses on protection through protection monitoring, a dedicated protection helpline and a referral system to service providers mapped within the region.

Our helpline is a free and dedicated phone service that provides advice and support by offering you referrals to relevant service providers. These referrals are based on your needs and on the services we can provide.

We are the link between you and service providers.
