I. SUPPOR	T TO CSO'S (CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS) IN THE LIBYAN MUNICIPALITIES
Background	The present project will aim in particular at assisting civil society actors operating in the targe municipalities to build their capacities and support the development of community-stabilizatio projects. Thus, the overall objective of the present action is to empower civil society actors in small an medium-sized municipalities on the migration routes in Libya so they are able to actively participate in local economic and social development efforts. The specific objective is to build the capacities of CSO located on the targeted municipalities to enhance the impact of their work and better collaborate with LAs to address local needs and promote the inclusion of vulnerable groups in local development efforts.
	Interventions within the framework of this project will be implemented over the period of 2 calenda years and 4 months (28 months) starting on 01/11/2017 and ending on 28/02/2020.
	Specific Objective: To support CSO's (civil society organizations) in Libyan Municipalities.

Objectives	The website development agency is a local Libyan consultant providing its service to ACTED for th designing and maintenance of an online platform aiming at facilitating knowledge sharing and cooperation among civil society organizations operating in the target municipalities.
