

# 3P Consortium

## Reducing Disaster Risk Vulnerability in Eastern Ukraine

With a view to reduce vulnerability to disaster risk in eastern Ukraine, a group of international and national organizations have come together under the leadership of ACTED to form the **3P Consortium**.

Through the implementation of activities in raions and municipalities which **border the line of contact** and where **industrial/ecological hazards** are located, the Consortium will **improve understanding** of, and **promote and take measures** towards, **preparedness** to industrial and ecological risks – including those exacerbated by the conflict. Over 18 months, the 3P Consortium will target **15,150 individuals and 45 organizations** through the realization of **three objectives**:

- **Advocate** for legislative gaps and investment priorities and enhance coordination amongst key stakeholders at national level;
- Improve **understanding** of risks and strengthen risk management capacity at district and regional levels;
- Enhance **community** awareness, preparedness and response at local level.
