
3P Consortium

Reducing Disaster Risk Vulnerability in Eastern Ukraine

With a view to reduce vulnerability to disaster risk in eastern Ukraine, a group of international and national organizations have come together under the leadership of ACTED to form the 3P Consortium.

Through the implementation of activities in raions and municipalities which border the line of contact and where industrial/ecological hazards are located, the Consortium will improve understanding of, and promote and take measures towards, preparedness to industrial and ecological risks – including those exacerbated by the conflict. Over 18 months, the 3P Consortium will target 15,150 individuals and 45 organizations through the realization of three objectives:

- •Advocate for legislative gaps and investment priorities and enhance coordination amongst key stakeholders at national level;
- •Improve understanding of risks and strengthen risk management capacity at district and regional levels;
- •Enhance community awareness, preparedness and response at local level.
