Reducing Disaster Risk Vulnerability in Eastern Ukraine

With a view to reduce vulnerability to disaster risk in eastern Ukraine, a group of international and national organizations have engaged in two eponymous projects, both implemented by the ACTED-led 3P Consortium. Through the implementation of activities in raions and municipalities which **border the line of contact** and where **natural and industrial/ecological hazards** are located, the Consortium will:

- **improve understanding** of, and **promote and take measures** towards, **preparedness** to natural and industrial/ecological risks,
- **advocate** for legislative gaps and investment priorities and enhance coordination amongst key stakeholders at national level,
- **improve** coordination on Disaster Risk Management amongst aid actors and local authorities and strengthen risk management capacity at district and regional levels,
- enhance **community** awareness, preparedness and response at local level,
- **increase** water safety in target communities that are exposed to disaster risk.
