## Reducing Disaster Risk Vulnerability in Eastern Ukraine

With a view to reduce vulnerability to disaster risk in eastern Ukraine, a group of international and national organizations have have engaged in two eponymous projects, both implemented by the ACTED-led 3P Consortium. Through the implementation of activities in raions and municipalities which border the line of contact and where natural and industrial/ecological hazards are located, the Consortium will:

- •improve understanding of, and promote and take measures towards, preparedness to natural and industrial/ecological risks,
- •advocate for legislative gaps and investment priorities and enhance coordination amongst key stakeholders at national level,
- •improve coordination on Disaster Risk Management amongst aid actors and local authorities and strengthen risk management capacity at district and regional levels,
- •enhance community awareness, preparedness and response at local level,
- •increase water safety in target communities that are exposed to disaster risk.
