## **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

COVID-19 is a global challenge, and there are disparities in capacities to cope: some communities need extra help to face this threat. People in the Eastern Conflict Areas of Ukraine are more vulnerable to the COVID-19 pandemic because of their demographics, socio-economic situation, and the armed conflict, ongoing in their region since 2014. They need additional informational, material and psychosocial support. With this in mind, the 3P Consortium designed a project entitled "Prevention of Spread and Response to COVID-19 in Eastern Conflict Areas, Ukraine", to support people, communities and authorities prepare for and cope with this crisis.

The purpose of the project is to prevent the spread of and increase response capacities to COVID-19 in the Eastern Conflict Areas, Ukraine

**Beneficiaries:** elderlies, households (HHs) with multiple children, chronic illnesses. HH of healthcare workers

- 10 local authorities
- 25 humanitarian organizations
- 95,000 individuals (including through large outreach and distribution activities)

## Main activities of the project:

- Provision of technical and material support to local authorities
- Risk Communication and Community Engagement
- Provision of Psycho-Social Support services
- Distribution of hygiene kits to social institutions and individuals, and set up of emergency water stations
- Pump replacement in water stations in 6 settlements
- KAP (Knowledge, Attitude, Practice)
  Assessments

**Location:** all raions/municipalities bordering the contact line (GCA) for protection monitoring, assessment and risk communications activities\*

For targeted activities such as works, distribution and community engagement:

- Popasna raion (Luhansk oblast, GCA)
  Yasinovata, Volnovakha, Bakhmut raions
  (Donetsk oblast, GCA)
- Toretsk Municipality (Donetsk oblast, GCA)

## **Objectives of the project:**

- Enhance knowledge, attitudes and practices related to COVID-19 prevention and response among conflict-affected populations
- Safeguard water supply and improve hygiene in conflict-affected areas (improved water supply, distribution of hygiene kits and hygiene promotion activities)
- Reduce stress and fear among conflictaffected populations
