In the last decade, humanitarian crises have undergone significant changes

driven by shifts in global geopolitics, demographic pressures, prolonged conflicts, and the worsening impact of climate change-induced natural hazards.

In 2023,

50% of the global population requiring humanitarian aid lived in countries highly vulnerable to climate change while 39% resided in regions facing a combination of intense conflicts,

socio-economic fragility, and climate-related vulnerabilities.



GOING TOWARDS A 3ZERO WORLD

In 2015, Acted developed the 3ZERO strategy, linked to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and aiming to achieve Zero Exclusion, Zero Carbon and Zero Poverty (3ZERO). We do this by promoting a global, sustainable, and inclusive approach to meet the humanitarian, environmental and economic challenges faced by vulnerable communities around the world.

ZERO EXCLUSION because no one should be left behind

We strive for inclusion and integration of all individuals, irrespective of gender, ethnicity, religion, or social standing, into programs and initiatives to prevent anyone from being marginalized or overlooked.

ZERO CARBON because we only have one planet

We are committed to minimizing our carbon footprint by reducing emissions, embracing renewable energy sources, and advocating for sustainable practices within local communities.

ZERO POVERTY because poverty should not hold back potential

We focus on collaborating with communities to enhance their living standards by providing economic opportunities, bolstering resilience against climate change, and ensuring access to essential services such as water, healthcare, and education

THE 3ZERO HOUSES

The 3ZERO Houses, powered by Acted, serve as dynamic, inclusive, and sustainable hubs that aim to facilitate and accelerate local partnerships, innovations, and solutions dedicated to the realization of a 3ZERO world.

These spaces foster collaboration among various stakeholders, including local social and environmental enterprises, civil society organizations (CSOs), youth, and other changemakers.

The primary goal of the 3ZERO House is to accelerate a fair social and ecological transition within a country. This is achieved by integrating efforts to alleviate poverty, lower carbon footprints, and foster inclusivity, thereby promoting sustainable development in underserved local communities.

- 3ZERO community chats to share initiatives and create linkages among actors


DID YOU KNOW?

The Philippines grapples with pressing issues of food insecurity, poverty, and climate change. Despite economic growth, a significant portion of the population lacks stable employment and fails to benefit from this progress. Despite contributing only 0.2% to global emissions, the country faces severe climate-related challenges, experiencing an average of twenty typhoons annually. Over the past decade, climate-related hazards have caused losses totaling US\$10 billion, earning the Philippines the title of the world's most disaster-prone country in the 2022 World Risk Index.

The 3ZERO House in Tajikistan aims to boost economic inclusivity by fostering business ventures for micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises, as well as startups.

Additionally, it supports civil society organizations by providing trainings and financial support to ensure their sustainability and enhance dialogue with authorities. The 3ZERO House also advocates for citizen-led climate initiatives, emphasizing energy efficiency and the transition to renewable energy sources.

- Incubation and acceleration programs for startups and social entrepreneurs

- Awareness workshops and trainings on sustainable production and consumption

DID YOU KNOW?

Tajikistan faces major challenges from climate change and limited economic opportunities. The country is highly vulnerable to extreme weather events, exacerbating issues like glacier melting, erratic rainfall, and prolonged droughts. With over half the population reliant on agriculture, inefficient resource management and low investment heighten risks to livelihoods and food security. Labor out-migration and a lack of diverse income sources in rural areas further impede economic advancement.

The 3ZERO House in Sri Lanka revolves around an exhibition space dedicated to raising awareness and initiating discussions on vital topics such as plastic management, marine conservation, climate-related disasters, and gender equality.

Additionally, it actively addresses plastic waste management, circular economy, climate change, and disaster risk management through various initiatives, including an entrepreneurship program for social and environmental entrepreneurs, networking events, volunteering opportunities, and annual 3ZERO Hackathons aimed at empowering local changemakers.

DID YOU KNOW?

Sri Lanka faces significant challenges in waste management and the circular economy, with only 30% of waste managed and a mere 3% recycled. Another concern for the country is brain drain, with Sri Lanka ranking 20th globally and 9th in the South Asian region in 2023. Nevertheless, the country possesses immense potential, with a high literacy rate of 93% and a strong foundation in renewable energy, including wind and hydroelectric power.

Located in the heart of Yangon in a century-old building, it offers customized training programs covering crucial topics such as waste management, climate-smart agriculture and social innovation. The 3ZERO House aims to empower birmanese with skills to tackle environmental challenges and foster sustainability in their communities.

DID YOU KNOW?

Myanmar grapples with the dual challenges of climate change and poverty, aggravated by extreme weather events, agricultural disruptions, and natural resource degradation, particularly affecting impoverished communities. Additionally, the fallout from the 2021-2022 crises—stemming from the military coup and COVID-19—has further exacerbated these challenges. Many startups and social enterprises have halted operations due to a lack of support amidst economic turmoil, compounding existing issues like inflation and infrastructure deficits.

The mission of the 3ZERO Village is to assist businesses and civil society affected by the 2023 earthquakes, empowering vulnerable groups to advance the 3ZERO agenda and promote sustainable economic growth.

Prioritizing Zero Poverty, it offers commercial spaces and operational support to those in need, while advocating for Zero Exclusion by including underrepresented and marginalized groups. Additionally, through Zero Carbon efforts, the village utilizes eco-friendly wooden houses and climate-smart solutions to reduce environmental impact.

DID YOU KNOW?

The February 2023 earthquakes devastated Antakya, with 3,100 buildings collapsing and over 20,000 lives lost. The destruction caused almost \$148.8 billion in damage, nearly 10% of Turkey's GDP. Hatay province, where Antakya is located, suffered the most, with half its population displaced and the highest death toll. Reconstruction efforts face challenges as unemployment and poverty rates soar. The region's vulnerability to climate change underscores the urgent need for support in this predominantly agrarian area.


