## **Acted Ukraine**

## Integrated critical humanitarian assistance to address the multisectoral needs of severely conflict-affected and frontline communities in Ukraine.



Acted has been operational in Ukraine since 2015, responding to emergency and longer-term needs of vulnerable, marginalised, and conflict-affected populations living along the former Line of Conflict (LoC) in Donetska and Luhanska oblasts, expanding operations into Khersonska and the Sea of Azov area in late 2021. After February 2022, Acted significantly expanded its presence and capacity countrywide. With 13 offices across Ukraine and over 500 staff, Acted has the capacity to reach all Ukrainian-controlled territory and parts of Non-Government Controlled Areas (NGCA) remotely. Acted delivers tailored and evidencebased assistance to people in need across three area contexts: frontline, early recovery, and IDP-hosting.

Under this project, Acted addresses key humanitarian priorities by delivering essential aid to hard-to-reach and frontline areas with significant intersectional needs.

Firstly, Acted's intervention provides multipurpose cash assistance to help beneficiaries meet their most essential needs. Additionally, shelter light and medium repairs, along with distribution of emergency shelter materials, will improve living conditions for conflict-affected households. These interventions are implemented in an integrated manner and are complemented by mobile protection services delivered through local partners, including mental health and psychosocial support and legal protection services.

The intervention provides in-kind support with essential Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) supplies, such as bottled water, water filters, boilers, and hygiene kits. The strengthens community infrastructure by providing WASH and infection prevention supplies and rehabilitating sanitary facilities and heating systems. Additionally, Acted restores critical water, wastewater, solid waste, and heating systems for public utilities in conflict-affected areas, equipping them to sustain essential services.
