The complainants stated that the shelter was not completed properly as it lacks a concrete foundation and was placed directly on rocks and bare ground. The inside floor remains covered with soil and many stones, creating unsafe conditions that may cause harm to the children attending classes. The complainants expressed their concern about this situation and requested Acted to urgently complete the rehabilitation by providing a proper concrete base to ensure the shelter is safe and suitable for children's learning. They also attached photos showing the difficulties children are facing while studying inside the shelter.
